CHAIRPERSON'S REPORT:

- Visit by group from Edwards Crossing went well.
- Denis acknowledged Jeff Morgan's efforts in preparing the site. (D Roberts and D Cheriton wetted the site down and their efforts are acknowledged too.)

GENERAL BUSINESS:

- D Cheriton reported that the shed will be delivered on 21 March and footings poured on 24 March.
- It is estimated that we will come in under budget.
- J Morgan moved and B Gowling seconded that we purchase a 22000 litres tank in the paperbark colour, to collect water from the shed. CARRIED
- Consideration will be given to runoff.
- Farm Fair Display: it was decided that the P6 tractors will be taken down for display. J Cooper to organise signage to explain the item on display and E Kerr to organise a sign to promote the Historical Society. Signs will be printed by Vista Print.
- Moline tractor: J Cooper to look into other options for sandblasting.
- Erection of boundary fence was discussed and it was decided to use the railway iron for posts.
- Grants: E Kerr brought the grants, as published in the Community Newsletter, to the attention of the meeting. A suggestion was made for an access path for walkers, gophers and wheelchairs. Further consideration will be given after the shed is built.
- B Gowling offered a scrub roller and Majestic plough. Executive to check out. Both items are very relevant to the pioneering history of the area.
- There has been an offer of a binder to add to our collection. It is expected that further offers will be made with the building of the shed for storage.
- E Kerr reported that Tim Bowles has offered his expertise in metal work. He has a background in blacksmithing.
