



On Thursday 25th November 'Girlie' Henriksen was formally laid to rest in the Wynarka cemetery in the presence of family and a number of local identities including Council CEO Martin Borgas. The service was led by Don Loller a local lay preacher from Karoonda.

' Girlie Henriksen' was the Granddaughter of John James Chenoweth and Sophia (nee Hunt) who farmed in the Wynarka area in the late 1910's.

'Girlie', who was unnamed at birth, was the second child of Haakon Daniel Henriksen and Alice (nee Chenoweth) and born on the 25th November 1921 but tragically lived for only 4 hours. It was always thought that 'Girlie' was laid to rest at Wynarka but Council records do not support this. A diary entry of a (later) Aunt supports the fact the she was laid to rest in the Wynarka cemetery.

Great Grandchildren of John and Sophia have erected a memorial in the Wynarka cemetery to ensure that she is not forgotten.

The family would like to thank CEO Martin Borgas and Don Loller for their support in achieving this goal.

KAROONDA AND DISTRICT HISTORICAL SOCIETY

Pioneer Park continues to be a popular place to visit particularly by the many visitors who have been staying in the town. Unfortunately, we cannot leave buildings open all the time but do make it known that buildings are open on working bee days. A small band of volunteers keep chipping away at the jobs to be done. New shelving has been installed in the container and the contents sorted, displays have been added and mounted properly on walls, and interpretive signage in the machinery shed has





been rejuvenated painstakingly by one of our younger members. We welcome anyone who would like to come and help our volunteers particularly with the jobs requiring specific trade skills.

We appreciate the contribution that Council has made to the development of the park with the installation of the toilet facility, pathways throughout the park and delivery of bark chips.

The telephone exchange display has been completed and has had a visit from former telephonist Mrs Fay Barr who worked in the exchange until she married and then part time later in her life. She also worked at the GPO in Adelaide in the trunk exchange which was located in a corrugated iron building separate from the main exchange. The manual exchange in Karoonda went automatic in 1988 but until then a telephone call was made by an operator using a cord with a plug at each end. As a caller rang in a small shutter would drop to reveal the **caller's number. 'Number please' t**he operator would say and take one end of the cord and plug into a socket (jack) corresponding to the number. The exchange operated 24 hours a day with three shifts. Local calls were not timed

but had to be recorded for payment and trunk calls were timed. 'Three minutes are you extending?' Dockets were written out by hand for these calls.



Trish and Steve Binney have donated an old school desk and two Pullman chairs which were used by the Commissioner of Railways in the railway carriage in which he travelled whilst visiting country areas. These have been placed in the Railway Museum carriage and shed.

The altar from 'All Hallows' Anglican Church and on loan from the Diocese of the Murray, has been placed in the Wynarka Church Museum. The Confessionals from the Catholic Church are also on display.

Meetings will now be held on the fourth Tuesday of the month in the Institute meeting room.



Working bees are advertised. We do go into a harvest recess over December and usually resume our meetings in January and organised working bees in February.

We would like to thank everyone for their efforts throughout the year. We wish you all a safe and joyous Christmas and look forward to life returning to some sort of normality in 2022.
