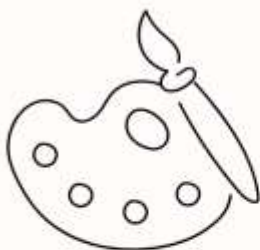

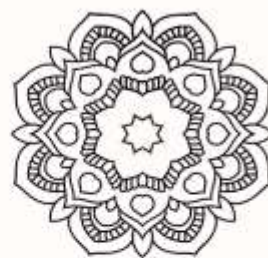

The 50th Celebrations of the Karoonda & Districts Soldiers memorial Hospital which was opened on the 14th of February 1973

On behalf of the Karoonda Hospital Auxiliary we would like to thank all that made the trip back to Karoonda, the community members and staff that came to help us Celebrate 50 years of having the Hospital in Karoonda. Allan Arbon (former Mayor of Karoonda) for speaking of all his knowledge on the day how the Hospital came about to be built and how so many people were involved in getting it to happen for the Karoonda Community.

It was a successful afternoon catching up over a cuppa with past nursing staff, Co Ordinator's, Board Members, Kitchen/cooks, Administration, Laundry, Maintenance & Executive Officers. Many stories were told, and photos to look back on over the years, with lots of laughs.

The Hospital Auxiliary have played a vital role in providing the ongoing improvements made to Equipment/outdoor areas etc, for the Residents comfort and wellbeing. We meet monthly and are always looking for new members.

Allan Arbon

I was Chairman of Council in 1970 and there was a problem with the local hospital being inadequate. The board had no funds to build a new one so they approached Council for the money. I was then nominated as Council representative on the hospital board.

Bert Shard was Chief Secretary of the Government, (today would be the Health Minister). We took a deputation to Bert Shard as the Council had no funds and already in debt by \$20 000, and in a drought.

We produced our plans for a fourteen bed hospital with an eight bed nurses quarters, costed at \$340 000 dollars, even with a two to one subsidy we would still have to find or borrow over a \$100 000 dollars.

I was representative of Hundred of Hoper and my rate payers voted against borrowing the money, with all other wards voting yes. I had to vote no for Hooper, but as chairman I supported the majority of rate payers.

We put these figures before Bert Shard and he said Karoonda needed a hospital as it was forty five minutes away for any other Hospital. He offered us a two to one subsidy then another special two to one meaning we got a four to one subsidy and were able to build the hospital with a borrowing of \$68 000 dollars.

Some years later the Hospital Board told me they were in a position to pay back some of the loan, but said there was no rule that said they could. I contacted Geoff Virgo, Minister for Local Government, and he rang me two days later to say there wasn't any ruling to say they could, but also no ruling to say they could not.

So it all worked out well in the finish, and Karoonda got the new Hospital with council borrowing only 468 000, which the hospital was able to pay back over time.

I must say that if Dr Murdoch had not had the vision or the persistence persuasion at the time, it may have taken longer to get this hospital.
